Depending on the season of the year, for your ideal field trip or weekend in Babina Greda, we will recommend stepping into the boots of Slavonian hog farmer, or joining us for a carriage ride into the fields, in order to find out whether the grain is ripe. You will come with us to pick up plums, and if you come a week or two later, you will learn how to make genuine rakia brandy, smooth and gentle. Would you like some homemade pastries or winter-preserved food to take with you? Just say it, and it's there!



Through the presentation of the Babina Greda Interpretation Center you will get to know our cultural heritage and the ways of life in the past. At the nearby hippodrome you will ride a white Lipizzaner horse of Babina Greda. As you may have already noticed, to us horses are a matter of culture, not an agriculture. To be honest, the same goes for food as well. In addition to the Interpretation Center you will find a souvenir shop, and in it - since we are practical - a refrigerator full of best delicacies of Babina Greda!



Where are we?

Babina Greda has a direct link to a highway A3 (E70), so it's easily accessible by car. In 1-2 hour drive you can reach us from several regional and national centers (Zagreb, Belgrade, Osijek, Pecs, Novi Sad, Tuzla, Banja Luka). Five of them are also international airports ([Zagreb](#), [Belgrade](#), [Osijek](#), [Banja Luka](#), [Tuzla](#)) Regional centers such as Vukovar, Vinkovci, Slavonski Brod or Đa-

kovo are up to an hour away. Nearest railway stations, part of international corridor X (*Orient Express* route), are in Strizivojna-Vrpolje and Vodinci, 20 km from Babina Greda.



By car, bicycle or a train?

As we have already said, the fastest way to get to Babina Greda is by road. The car is a good option for a family outing, a comfortable exploration of our area (80 sq km), or if you want to fit Babina Greda into a bigger trip. If you prefer the “Easy Rider” style, the motorcycle is also a great solution (there is a small motorcycle community in the village).

There’s a belief that Babina Greda is a somewhat peculiar village. Unique we may be, but that doesn’t mean we’re alone in the universe. If you would like to combine car or a train with a bicycle, give us a call! We know several interesting routes comprising both Babina Greda, and interesting villages nearby – Sikirevci, Kruševica, Slavonski Šamac, Štitar, Gundinci, Retkovci, Prkovci. Along the way you’ll meet real local people, and discover authentic destination. Depending on your wishes, *combo trips* (car + bike) can be planned as one-day or two-day, with overnight stays in guesthouses, households, or outdoors by the campfire. If staying three or more days, we will take you to a nearby city-break gems – Županja, Vinkovci or Đakovo.
